Negro Canyon Hike, Sunday, June 27th

Explore this beautiful canyon with Gregory Creek flowing through it to Donner Lake. This hike features spectacular views and should have abundant wildflowers. Moderate ups and downs. Bring a snack. Duration: 2-3 hrs. **Meet at 9:30am, Directions:** Take I 80 West to the Donner Lake Interchange. Once on the exit road, take the first road to your right, and then the first right choice again and park by the Truckee Donner Land Trust informational sign.

McGlashan Springs Hike, Sunday, July 25th

Enjoy incredibly diverse and rich wetlands featuring many rare varieties of wild flowerers, as well as panoramic views. Learn about this area's unique contribution to Truckee's history. Moderate ups and downs and does involve some off trail scrambling so wear long pants. Bring a snack. Duration: 1.5-2.5 hrs.

Meet at 10:00 AM, Directions: In Tahoe Donner, take the westbound (not northbound) Northwoods. Turn left on Skislope. Almost immediately, turn left again into Bermgarten and park.

Far Western Martis Valley Hike, Sunday, August 22nd

Discover this hidden gem of a hike that traverses forest, riparian areas, aspen groves, and meadows. Observe

different styles of forest management and learn about MAPF's efforts to protect the Valley.

Gentle slopes. Bring a snack. Duration 2-3hrs. **Meet at 9 AM, Directions:** We will meet at the 7-11 center at the corner of Palisades and Brockway road, across from the regional park and then caravan, and car pool to the trail head.
